| space    | open area without anything solid in it  |
| fence    | wood or metal barrier that marks a boundary   |
| price    | cost or expense of an item or service   |
| office   | room or set of rooms where business is done   |
| police   | officers who protect people and fight crime   |
| pencil   | a wooden tool used for writing or marking   |
